

Admission Process




Be sure that you can provide proof of residency in Orleans Parish by June 1, 2018.

Submit complete applications and required documentation via the following methods:

- Pick up an application from the school and hand deliver to LFC
- Download an application from www.lakeforestcharter.org and email application with supporting documentation to admissions@lakeforestcharter.org
- Mail application - ***LFC is not responsible for applications sent via US mail that are not tracked.**

Assessment/Orientation

Applicants will be scheduled to  assess when the application is received by LFC. All applicants must assess at Lake Forest to be considered for admission. If a student would like to use testing accommodations, a copy of the IAP/504 plan should be submitted with the application. Orientations are scheduled on assessment Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. —10:00 A.M. while students are testing. (See FAQ for dates).

Phase I

Phase I of the application process is comprised of application submission, assessment and orientation. All applicants will receive score notification two weeks after they have taken the assessment at LFC. Students must score a minimum of 8 combined points on the Kindergarten assessment and 11 combined points on the 1st—8th grade assessment to proceed to Phase II.

Phase II

Once students have achieved the minimum combined score on the admission assessment, the total matrix score is calculated in Phase II. Total matrix scores with results will be mailed to applicants by February 28, 2018.
