


Admission FAQ's



When are the orientation meetings?

- Saturday, December 9, 2017
- Saturday, January 6, 2018
- Saturday, January 20, 2018

All applicants must attend the full orientation to receive the corresponding matrix points.

Orientations will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will conclude at 10:00 a.m.

Attendance will be verified by sign-in sheets and parents will be able to complete the Parental Survey that will be distributed at the end of the parent orientation meeting.

Points will be assigned for attendance and submission of survey.

Is there a sibling rule?

Yes.

Siblings of Current Lake Forest students that qualify for admission will receive the first available seats. Should there be no available seats, siblings will receive top placement on the waiting list.



When can I tour the school?

We love for our prospective parents to see us in action during the school day. We conduct tours for prospective parents every Thursday at 9:00 A.M.

Parents are asked to sign in at the front office by 8:50 A.M. and the 30 minute tour will begin promptly at 9:00 A.M.

When will I find out if my child has been accepted?

Phase I results will be mailed 2 weeks after your child has taken the assessment.

All admission results with final matrix scores will be communicated via US Mail by February 28, 2018. All results are mailed using the self-addressed envelopes you provide.
